

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
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Introduction to Visual Communication ICT03

Welcome to an Introduction to Visual Communication. This Year 10 subject will introduce you to some key ideas and concepts in visual communication and introduce you to computer based illustration and photography using Adobe software packages, Illustrator and Photoshop.

Visual communication is something we encounter every day in signs, advertisements, books, posters, packaging, brochures, cards, multimedia presentations, the internet, magazines, TV and film and other forms of media.

What is it that makes a visual design work effectively to clearly communicate its message?

It could be the combination of the text and graphics or the way the image is made to communicate an idea or feeling. By understanding how these messages are communicated we can learn to make effective visual designs.
